#### ROAD TO GAU - M. ALEKSIDZE ST. №10, TBILISI





GAU was founded 11 years ago at Metekhi Street № 22 with 292 students in 2 faculties: Schools of Busi ness and Law.

In 2007, GAU expanded and moved to Chavchavadze Avenue (Alleyway II, №5).

In 2011 – 2013, new faculties were added: Schools of Informatics & Engineering and Humanitarian Sciences & Liberal Arts.

In 2013, OPIC, a U.S. Government developmental organization, provided a loan of US\$3,500,000 to GAU for the purchase and renovation of a building at Merab Aleksidze Street Nº 10. The building was renovated in accordance with the most stringent OPIC and international standards. New equipment was added and new programs were opened. The OPIC loan continues until 2023.

#### GAU IS THE FOUNDER OF THE QUANT PROFESSION IN GEORGIA

Since 2006, there has been a QUANT program at GAU for students with a particular interest in studying Quantitative Finance. These specialists are in great demand and as a rule take prestigious and highly paid positions in leading financial institutions, both here in Georgia and abroad.

#### GAU RESEARCH INSTITUTES AND SCIENTIFIC WORK

GAU prides itself on its centers of research where professors and students conduct scientific exploration. GAU professors apply for and are awarded various grants for scientific research with foreign universities. GAU professors belong to a small and elite group of scientists whose articles are peer reviewed and published in international impact-factor journals.



## TEMPUS - GAU COORDINATES JOINT MASTER'S PROGRAM BETWEEN UNIVERSITIES

The Master's program, "European Integration and Employment Relations EIGER" is executed by two Universities in Georgia and financed by the European Union (ECEA-TEMPUS). The Master's Program is an interdisciplinary Master's Program which is coordinated by GAU. Graduate students are able to attend this program in three Georgian Universities simultaneously and then prepare a master's thesis in any of the foreign partner universities:

- Free University of Brussels (Belgium)
- European College of Economics and Management, Plovdiv (Bulgaria)
- University of Magdeburg (Germany)
- University of Santiago de Compostela (Spain)

The annual tuition fee of the Master's Program is 2,250 GEL.

Classes are taught in Georgian. Further, the program is equipped with a modern Georgian and English library located at GAU.

Due to GAU's leadership and the successful implementation of the Eiger Project, a new international project Erasmus + Establishing Labor Observatories in Georgia and Moldova (OBSERVE) is being developed. GAU continues to be the project lead university.



#### GAU IS THE FIRST FOUNDER OF A LEGAL CLINIC IN GEORGIA








GAU Legal Clinic in the Law, Social Sciences & Diplomacy School was established in 2008. GAU is the leader who introduced this practical and effective method of legal clinic studies in Georgia. The Legal Clinic develops legal thinking and practical skills of advocacy in students by granting free legal help to vulnerable groups.

Bachelor students in their final year and LLM (Master's) students team up with mentoring university lecturers and lawyers. Together they provide free legal consultations, and represent civil cases in Court. The students are further educated in areas of human rights and they learn how to use legal disciplines in practice. This process vastly increases their competitiveness and employment opportunities and also helps to develop a sense of social responsibility.

#### GAU PROVIDES STUDIES OF PROFESSIONAL ENGLISH



Teaching of professional English has been the top priority since the very first day of GAU.

- When students enter GAU, the level of their knowledge in English language can be at the minimum level required for passing the national unified exam. While mastering the subjects of their profession, GAU students also learn professional English, specific vocabulary, phraseology, and idiomatic and specialized language communication skills.
- GAU has English-speaking professors who have vast experience working with foreign partners and colleagues.
- One of the main priorities at GAU is providing modern English textbooks. GAU annually acquires textbooks that are also used in leading Universities in the United States and Europe.



#### GAU DEVELOPS A PROFESSION OF THE FUTURE





As a winner of the competition held by the Georgian Innovation and Technology Agency (GITA), in 2015 GAU founded GeoLab, an institute and research laboratory with ultramodern IT equipment. GAU has two partners for this project: Leavingstone and Geocell. The IT institute conducts research and teaches the following subjects:

- 3D Design Animation
- Modeling
- Graphic Design Interface Design
- Illustration
- Coding Mobile and Web Applications Languages
- Electronic Platforms
- IT Project Management

Georgia has a huge potential in the field of mobile applications but lacks qualified personnel. The main goal of GAU and its partners for GeoLab is the development ofthis profession for young generations and further support of student employment.

GAU and GeoLab joint enrollment program has had many successful alumni. In the frames of Hackathon and other international competitions - many innovative and usable software and mobile applications were created by students of GAU's Informatics & Engineering School. GeoLab regularly holds open public lectures, training sessions and master classes with international experts.

GeoLab is the only Information Technology Laboratory in South Caucasus, works 24/7 - and is always ready to develop interesting and useful ideas.

## GAU HAS A GROWING NUMBER OF EMPLOYED STUDENTS AND GRADUATES



GAU is the leader in Georgia with the hiring rate of its verycompetitive students and graduates. GAU graduates and students are employed by State and private entities and leading international organizations. They include the National Bank, TBC Bank, TBC Leasing, Bank of Georgia, Bank Republic, Aldagi BCI, GPI Holding, Cartu Group, Cartu Bank, Procredit Bank, PwC, Saunders Group, Zviad Kordzadze Law Bureau, Ministry of Internal Affairs, Ministry of Justice, Prosecutor's Office, Ministry of Economy and Sustainable Development, Ministry of Finance, Tbilisi City Court, Notary Chamber of Georgia, Tbilisi City Council, International Human Rights Institute and many many others.

According to statistics, almost 100% of all GAU graduates and 60% of students still studying at GAU (undergraduates) are employed.

GAU supports the planning of a student's career utilizing various projects. As a member of the American Chamber of Commerce in Georgia (AmCham), through the AmCham Youth Leadership program, GAU is able to provide select students with practical trainings and mentoring led by private sector leaders and experts in the following directions: time management, presentation and leadership skills, conflict resolution, IPR, business communications and others. The mentoring is then followed by opportunities for internships in AmCham companies.

U.S. Air Force Academy cadets started studying at GAU in September 2014 as part of their semester abroad program and continues annually. In addition to GAU lecturers, Georgian Military Officers also provide lectures in Military History. The program is annually executed based on a memorandum signed between GAU and the US Air Force.

Foreign students in GAU obtain a higher education with courses in: Political Science, Post-Soviet Foreign and Domestic Policy Fields, World History, Russian Language, Business and Finance Management.

Dozens of foreign students have graduated from GAU since 2005. They arrived in Georgia from various countries, including the U.S., Colombia, Israel, Russia, China, Egypt, India, Iran, Turkey, Kazakhstan, Nigeria, Syria and others.



## GAU INITIATED COLLABORATION WITH HIGHER AND SECONDARY EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS








In 2015, at the initiation of Georgian American University, public discussions on the modern challenges of education, teaching methods and new approaches to public discussions were held with higher and secondary education institutions. The project is supported by the Ministry of Education, National Center for Teacher Professional Development and Accreditation Center.

Regular meetings and discussions are held with teachers and administrators to identify ways to solve current and expected problems. GAU created a space and format for discussion where university professors, guest speakers, and representatives of the permanent schools are brought together. The ultimate goal of the project is to improve the country's young generation and create approaches for developing highly qualified personnel.

#### GAU CARES FOR YOUTH EDUCATION FROM SCHOOL AGE







GAU's involvement in the educational processes is diverse. It works together with private and public schools in Georgia. GAU encourages successful students and helps them determine the correct course of their future. According to memoranda signed with schools, GAU allows high performing students to participate in university subjects and academic programs. For teachers, GAU has a number of seminars and trainings which serve one purpose – working together to raise the quality of education.

BMB (Building and Managing a Business) Certificate Course students and lecturers held meetings in Georgia's different regions with open classes for the 11th and 12th grade high school students on the subjects of professional orientation and career planning.

Project "GAU Challenge" (created within the collaboration between GAU and Mind Technology") provides training, including innovative teaching methods free of charge for English teachers in over 200 schools, School English language Olympiads are held regularly, including presentations, competitions, training sessions and tours of the area. GAU Summer School operates with an educational program consisting of intellectual, sports and recreational activities.

During the school year, interested school students can take part in an English language presentation competition on various topics and an essay contest (in the area of Law and International Relations). GAU professors, students and high school students participate in mock trials and other types of real-life simulations.

"GAU Band" is one of the most active and fun parts of student life at GAU.















#### GAU TAKES SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY SERIOUSLY
